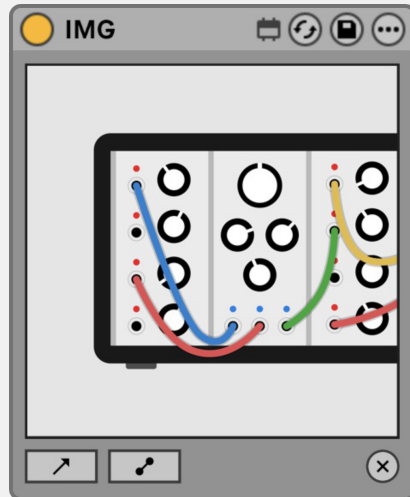




IMG Getting Started Guide



IMG is a simple way to store and display images directly in your Ableton Live sessions.

Use IMG to store pictures of hardware settings, handwritten session notes or even just some visual inspiration — and it's all right there in your Live Set.

Installing IMG



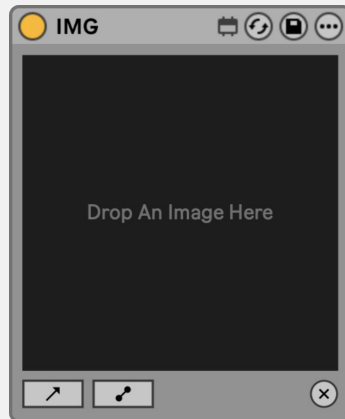
IMG.amxd

Inside the folder you downloaded, you will find an IMG.amxd file — this is a Max For Live device file. To load it in Ableton Live, drag and drop it onto any Track in your project.

Note that you will need Max For Live installed to use IMG. Max For Live is included with Ableton Live Suite and can be purchased as an add-on for Ableton Live Standard.


Using IMG




IMG is fairly straightforward to use; drag and drop an image file onto the area that says “Drop An Image Here” to load the image file into the device.

IMG supports most image file type (jpg, png, gif, etc.). You can even drop a movie file an IMG will display the first frame of the movie.


Controls


Click the  toggle in the bottom left of the device to open a resizable popup window.

Click the  icon to clear the currently loaded image.

Automating The Popup Note

There are some important considerations when automating the popup note.

The  icon is used exclusively for opening the popup note with the mouse or for MIDI mapping to. It should **NOT** be automated.

The  icon should be used to automate the popup note. Right-click and choose Show Automation then draw in automation as you would for any other control. This button will have no function while Live's timeline is not running.
